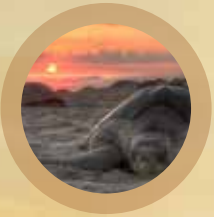

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Muscat City Tour (Full Day) – “Mystic Muscat”

4WD



Timing – Full Day (8 Hours)

The tour starts with a visit of the Royal Opera House, Oman's premiere venue for musical arts and culture.

A visit to the Grand Mosque, standing in stately grandeur. It is one of the beautiful and extravagant modern mosque in the world, a blend of Islamic, Middle Eastern and Omani architectural styles.

Amouage Factory, the Muscat home of the world's most valuable perfume, "The gift of kings".

We continue with the Fish and vegetable market in Muttrah. Feel free to mingle with the crowd.

Visit the Muttrah Souq where you will find a mix of old and new. Sights, sounds and fragrances are in abundance. You then enjoy the Corniche and at the Sultan's Palace flanked by the 16th Century Portuguese forts of Jalali and Mirani.

You visit Bait Al Zubair Museum for a fine display of Omani culture and history. You must be hungry now, so is time for lunch in a local restaurant.

Qantab, fishermen village, Bandar Khayran, famous for its breathtaking beauty of wild beaches, coral reef and exotic marine life. Get a flavor of the Muscat memorable coastline and Khayran village. Wadi Mayh, with towering limestone cliffs, sand color villages, back garden date plantations, straying goats and feral donkeys, will be our next photo shoot stop and off road driving for 20 min.

Muscat City - Half Day Tour



The tour first takes you to Azaibah where you will find the Grand Mosque standing in stately grandeur (Open 8am to 11 am, Saturday through Thursday). Next visit the fish, fresh fruits and vegetable market at Muttrah. Feel free to mingle with the crowd. From here take a walk to the Muttrah Souq where you will find a mix of old and new sights, sounds and fragrances are in abundance. Drive past the Corniche and to Old Muscat for a photo stop at the Sultan's Palace flanked by the Portuguese forts of Jalali and Mirani. Soon after, visit Bait Al Zubair Museum for a fine display of Omani culture and history.

Mystic Muscat

Muscat by Night



Muscat is beautiful by day, but the city takes on an exotic splendor at night. We start at the beautiful Grand Mosque for photo stop. Then drive along Embassy Road, which is lined by trees and streetlights that cast shadows on the beautiful Embassy buildings, which were designed like typical Arabic villas.

From here you will drive to Sultan Qaboos Port, Muscat's main trading port, and then the colorful Muttrah Souk for typical Omani souvenirs.

Your next stop is the Bait Al Zubair Museum, one of the most informative museums in Oman, which focuses on the country's fascinating history and the traditional culture and lifestyle of the people of the Sultanate. From here we continue onwards to see the magnificent Al Alam Palace, the Sultan's exquisite waterside palace. This is guarded by the imposing Jalali and Mirani forts, built by the Portuguese in the 16th century. On the way back we drive through the old city of Muscat.

Coastal Trek

Wadi Shaab - 4WD



Depart Muscat in the morning on a journey down the coast stopping at the fishing village of Qurayyat and then proceed to Bimah Sinkhole, a geological feature and a scenic wonder. Further on is the white sandy beach of Mokhalla in Fins. From here it is a short drive to Wadi Shaab, where you can take a hike up one of Oman's scenic wadis. At the end of the hike is a swim through a famous keyhole into the secluded world of thrilling fantasy. After a day of adventure return to Muscat

The Grand Canyon of Oman **Jebel Shams - 4WD**



Depart Muscat in the morning in a/c 4WD and travel to the interior via Fanjah, Izki and Nizwa, stopping at Nizwa for a stroll through the Old Quarter of Nizwa and continuing onto Al Hamra. Stop at the old village of Ghul to see the abandoned Persian ruins. Soon after, travel up the canyon to Nakhr to explore the canyon and stop near Nakhr village for photo ops. You then drive via Ghul to the top of the canyon near to the summit of Jebel Shams. Enjoy the breathtaking view of the canyon. Later in the evening return to Muscat. • Highlights: Mountains and Canyons • Duration : Approx. 8 hours

Cool and Green Oman **Jebel Akhdar 4WD**



Depart in the morning by a/c 4WD. Stop at Fanjah for a photo stop to view an abandoned village. You then drive to Birkat Al Mouz, a pretty oasis known for its sheer scenic value. Drive to the roof of Oman, the Saiq Plateau, which for hundreds of years has been accessible only by donkeys. The sight of terraced gardens is very interesting. A variety of fruits like walnuts, pomegranates, apricot and lemon are grown here. There are many interesting walks in Wadi Bani Habib, Shrejaya and Aqur. The weather here is cool and dry. Return to Muscat in the evening. • Highlights : A day of soft adventure interspersed with culture and nature • Duration : Approx. 8 hours

Inspiring Interior **Nizwa, Bahla, Jabrin**



In the morning, we set out on a journey to the past through the Sumail Gap that divides the Western and Eastern Hajar Mountains and onto the old capital of Oman, Nizwa known for its silver Souq and the big round fort built during the period of the Yoruba dynasty. After visiting the Souq and the Fort, proceed to Bahla with the huge loam fort, which is under renovation at present. More notably, Bahla has been placed in the list of UNESCO's World Heritage Site for its cultural antiquity. Bahla is also known as the pottery capital of Oman. A few kilometers away lies Jabrin Fort, one of the most magnificent forts of Oman. Walk through the majestic Jabrin Castle and Fort. Return to Muscat by dusk. • Highlights : A study of culture and tradition in Oman • Duration : Approx. 7 hours

Desert Safari

Wahiba & Wadi Bani Khalid 4WD



Board an A/C 4wd as you drive through the Hajar Mountains. Stop over at Fanjah for a photo op. Then drive to see the ruins of an old mercantile community in Al Mansfah which saw its heydays hundreds of years ago. Head towards the enchanting Wadi Bani Khalid and drive past the village with its endless date plantations. In the Wadi itself, the pools are cool, deep and absolutely stunning. From here we drive to the undulating golden sands of Wahiba. Indulge in some daring dune bashing and then visit the bedouin settlement before returning to Muscat. • Highlights : A day filled with adventure as you experience Oman's diverse nature • Duration : Approx. 8 hours

Fascinating Forts

Nakhl, Rustaq



Depart west from Muscat in the morning. Your first stop is at Barka, a sea-side town with small souqs and a Fort along the shoreline. Move from here to Nakhl where you will visit Nakhl Fort, spectacularly perched on a rocky prominence of the Western Hajar Mountains. The Fort's origin is pre Islamic with major contributions by the Al Yoruba and the Al Busaid dynasties. Move inland to see the mineral laden hot springs and spend some time relaxing in the shades of date palms. Afterwards we take the loop and visit Rustaq to see a fort nestled in the foothills of the Western Hajars. In the evening return to Muscat. • Highlights : Historical and Cultural visits • Duration : Approx. 8 hours

Snake Canyon



The tour starts with a spectacular drive through the magnificent Batinah coastline to Snake Canyon. Snake Canyon is by far the most diverse and challenging of wadis. Every bend is a photo opportunity. Jumps into the crystal pools range from two to six meters into deep waters. The caverns add fun and extra challenges to the trek. Snake Canyon is an awesome hike although definitely not considered to be easy but, having completed it you will feel inspired. The name 'Snake Canyon' refers to the serpentine effect created by the water cutting through the mountains and the wadi snaking through. Our hike of approximately 6 hours. You will need to be an able swimmer in addition to being capable of climbing and jumping from boulders.

Wadi Bani Awf

4WD



The tour begins by driving along the magnificent Batinah coastline to Barka then heading south to the Oasis of Nakhal. Here you will visit the 17th Century Fort "Nakhal Fort" and visit the Oasis of Al Thowarah Hot Springs water where you can witness the source of the natural springs.

Our Next stop will be to Wadi Bani Awf which is renowned as one of the most fantastic tourist locations in the nearby area surrounding Muscat. Wadi Bani Awf leads to the famous Little Snake Gorge. It is an awesome hike through the wadi. We then discover Balad Sayt and its houses built on a rock overlooking a wonderful palm garden. We walk down to the village, through the gardens and head to a wide pass.

Sur



The tour starts from Muscat to the Fishing village of Quriyat - a short photo stop- From Quriyat continue to Bimah Sinkhole, a spectacular lime stone crater that had been created many years ago by a collapsing mountain. The hole is large and filled with sea water.

Then drive to the white sand beach of Finns for a photo stop. Continue to Wadi Shab and Wadi Tiwi. Finally drive on Sur – Sur is known to be the home of Sinbad the legendary mariner of the Arabian Nights. In Sur we visit the fishermen's and witness the fishermen's in action.

Proceed on the Dhow building yard, Dhows are traditional Omani wooden fisher boats that are even today, built by hand.

OVER NIGHT EXCURSIONS

Ras'al Hadd/Turtles 4WD



We set out in the morning on a journey down the coast. We stop off at Mazara village, Bimah Sink Hole, a geological feature and a scenic wonder and the Mokhalla beach where you can have your picnic. Stop at Qalhat to view Bibi Miriam's tomb before you reach the old East Africa port of Sur. Visit the dhow yards and a typical Omani village Ajjah before you reach Ras al Hadd. Check in at Ras al Hadd Hotel. After dinner visit the beach to observe the nesting habits of the green turtles.

Day 2: After breakfast drive along the coast via the bluffs at Ad Dhaffa and on to the interior via the desert woodlands. Near Ibra you stop off at Al Mansfah, to see the ruins of an old mercantile community which knew its hey days hundreds of years ago. Return to Muscat through the Hajar mountains. •Highlights: Nature, archaeology, culture

Wahiba Sands / Wadi Bani Khalid 4wd



Depart in the morning from Muscat to Fanjah and the Sumail Gap that divides the Western and Eastern Hajars. Visit the abandoned village of Al Mansfah near Ibra. Much of the charm and character of this old mercantile town has not washed away. Our next stop is the village of Mudharib, another thriving oasis. Lunch at a local restaurant. After lunch proceed to the golden undulating sands of Wahiba. Indulge in dune bashing. Enjoy the sunset atop a dune. Camel rides are optional. Enjoy a Bedouin dinner and overnight in a Desert Camp.

Day 2: After breakfast visit Bedouin settlements before proceeding to Wadi Bani Khalid with its endless date palms and crystal clear pools. Hike and swim in the inviting pools before returning to Muscat. •Highlights: Adventure and Nature

Jebel Shams / Wadi Nakhr Gorge 4WD



Leave Muscat in the morning and travel to the interior via Fanjah, Izki, and Nizwa where you will stop to take a stroll through the Old Quarter of Nizwa before continuing on to Al Hamra. Stop at the old village of Ghul to see the ruins of the abandoned Persian village and then travel up the canyon to Nakhr to meet the villagers. Have a picnic here. From Ghul, drive to the top of the Canyon near the summit of Jebel Shams. Visit the local weavers and haggle for their wares. Dinner and overnight at Jebel Shams Camp resort.

Day 2: After breakfast hike down the canyon rim 1 km above the floor to the abandoned terraces and cliff dwellings. Before you return to Muscat stop at Misfat al Abreen to see a picturesque village strapped on to the side of a mountain. •Highlights: Soft Adventure, Nature and Culture
